To achieve our objectives, we target our efforts at the definition of reform priorities and the strategy of their implementation, establishment of the system of expert and public influence on the reform process, information and education support to reforms, support to the development of the civil society capacity and synergy of actions for efficient promotion of reforms, popularisation of mechanisms and practices of public participation in the decision-making process, ongoing monitoring and assessment of the reforms implementation.
